Despite many Detroit connections, The Appreciations were a North Carolina outfit originally known as the Inspirations and managed by Hattie Leeper. Despite appearing on the famous Detroit label, the track was actually cut at the Arthur Smith Studios in Charlotte, N.C. backed by Moses Dillard and the Tex-Town Review. At this time the Sport label changed to Amy/Mala/Bell distribution with ANOTHER release on this number (Sport 111) by the Four Sonics. This is most likely the reason why this one is much rarer than their first release on Sport 'She Never Really Loved Me'. A pretty perfect condition copy too!
