Sam's first record recorded at Ed Boutwell's studios in Birmingham. Alabama in 1966 and famous for that thunderous bassline. A total Northern Soul classic now of course.

Another one from the eighties that would easily have made it big in the previous decade. A powerhouse production and rarer on the maroon label rather than the yellow label I would say. A small area of light scuffs have downgraded this one from mint condition.

Yes you saw the minimum bid correctly. Reason? Well to be honest this stone classic has some 'fuzz' all the way through it. Check the soundbite. Recorded on superior Technics equipment the track is as it sounds – NOT WORSE in real life – and at a venue its probably fine.

Elledge was a country singer who occasionally dipped his toe into black music with some skill. His version of 'Can't Stop a Man In Love' is excellent for instance.
