Indeed, she produced this excellent double-sider. Back in the day 'Come On, Let Me Love You' was the Northern side but 'Striving' slowly emerged as a crossover winner. This copy is in very nice condition but one Andrew Sands of Patton Drive, Philadelphia has placed his sticker on the 'Come On' side.
